

ITEM #11.2: Travel Policy for Board members, other bodies and the Secretariat

Travel Policy

1. Members of the Secretariat and of the Board, as well as key partners are/may in the future be required to travel on behalf of I-DAIR. The current travel policy is that of the Graduate Institute, that currently hosts I-DAIR.

Decision

- 2. The Board decides that I-DAIR will devise a new travel policy for the Board members, other bodies and the Secretariat that will be applicable from the moment it will be independent of the Graduate Institute.
- 3. This travel policy will be differentiated, according to the different needs and conditions of the Board, other bodies and the Secretariat.
- 4. It will consider issues related to safety, sustainable development and climate change, such as CO2 compensation as well as use of trains vs. planes.
- 5. It will submit such a policy by email before 1 December 2022.
